TO ALL PUTNAM COUNTY FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS:

We just received the order from Governor Eric J. Holcomb stating that all bars, nightclubs, and restaurants are required to close to in-person patrons. Your establishment may provide take-out and delivery services only. This directive from the Governor begins TODAY and is in effect until April 1, 2020. Your facility can convert operations to take out only.

This letter is to provide you with guidance to go with your self-responsibility to keep your employees and patrons safe. This is a continuing effort to slow the spread of COVID-19.

Recommendations for converting to take out only:

- Maintain at least 6 feet of distance between you and the patron
- Set up a way to take orders via phone or internet
- Clean and sanitize your facility

2. Environmental Cleaning and Disinfection Recommendations from CDC.
3. Interim Guidance for Businesses and Employers from CDC.

The Putnam County Health Department is following the guidelines from the Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
